

Housing Needs Assessment **2011**



Every three years, in accordance with Section 9 of the Housing Act 1988, housing authorities are required to undertake an assessment of housing need in their functional areas. This paper provides results from the 2011 assessment.

Background

In February 2011 housing authorities were directed by the Department of the Environment, Community and Local Government¹ to carry out an assessment of need existing at 31st March, 2011. Detailed guidance was issued by the Department to assist authorities in carrying out the assessment and in order to insure as much consistency as possible across authorities. This was to be a 'snap-shot' assessment based on an extract of data from each housing authority in respect of each household that has been approved for social housing support at 31st March, 2011. The Housing [Miscellaneous Provisions] Act, 2009 provides for a new process of housing assessment with effect from 1st April, 2011. This Assessment of Housing Need gives a national picture of the level of housing need across the country as these new regulations come into effect.

Before reviewing the tables below, the following points should be noted:

- **The methodology used to collect the 2011 data differs substantially from that used in previous years and therefore the 2008 and 2011 figures are not strictly comparable.** As explained above, this current assessment of housing need is a data extract from the housing system in respect of each household that has been approved for social housing support at 31st March, 2011. In previous recent years, authorities investigated their lists prior to the 31st March deadline to confirm that those on the list were still seeking and in need of social rented housing and contacted voluntary groups regarding local housing needs. This might explain some of the increase in need witnessed between 2008 and 2011, because the figures would include households that may no longer be in housing need but have not been taken off the list. Further research would be required, however, to test this theory. Comparative analysis of the 2008 and 2011 figures is, therefore, not provided (bar Table A1 in the Annex)
- **The figures presented below are based on net need;** that is, the number of households in need of housing support who are not currently receiving social housing support (those already in local authority, voluntary co-operative or RAS accommodation are excluded). It is

a measure of the number of households that cannot be accommodated through the existing stock available to housing authorities, Also, where an applicant has applied for social housing in more than one authority, the authority to which the applicant first applied is the one to which they are assigned for analytical purposes. Any additional applicants are then disregarded to calculate the net need figure.

Net Housing Need

The net housing need figure at present shows that 98,318 households were in need of social housing support at 31st March 2011. Table 1 shows that the largest category of need by far was those unable to meet the cost of accommodation – accounting for about two-thirds (66.8%) of households, with the next biggest category of need, medical and compassion reasons, accounting for one-tenth of households (9.7%) and this was followed by those involuntary sharing (8.7%). Older persons and homeless households respectively account for just over 2 per cent of need, while Traveller families, unfit accommodation and people with a disability each accounted for less than 2% of the country's net housing need.

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Table 2 summarises the structure of the households identified as being in need of social housing support in the 2011 assessment. Half (49.6%) of these households are single adult households; a quarter (25.2%) are family households with one child and a further 12% are family households with 2 children.

Table 3 illustrates the age profile of those seeking housing support and shows that most of those registered as in need of social housing are aged under 40 years of age (69%); with half (50%) aged between 26 and 40 years of age.

Table 4 below illustrates the citizenship of households in need of support. It shows that while most (70.5%) of households in housing need had Irish citizenship, almost one-third were non-Irish nationals, about two-thirds of which were EU citizens and one third were non-EU citizens. EU citizens accounted for 20% of households in need of support, while Non EU nationals accounted for 9% of this need.

Incomes of households in need of social housing support are quite low, as might be expected. Table 5 shows that over three-quarters of households (78.5%) in need of social housing had gross annual incomes of less than €15,000. Most of these households had gross incomes between €10,000 and €15,000. In total, 89.6% of households seeking housing support from local authorities had incomes of less than €20,000.

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Table 6 gives details of the length of time households had applied for social housing support. A little under a quarter of households (22.5%) had applied to the local authority for housing less than one year ago, but over a third of households (36.9%) had been waiting for social housing for over 3 years.
